Melbourne Quarter is located in the heart of Melbourne CBD. The brand new precinct is functioning as a commercial, residential and retail destination. The designated Electrical Sub-contractor awarded the security works to Systems Integrator, ECS Solutions Victoria for the commercial building, otherwise known as Building 2.

The building showcases a glazed glass facade, with multiple indoor & outdoor garden sanctuaries, enabling the location to boost productiveness & wellbeing. Woods Bagot, the architect on the project, have created a contemporary haven with the location of the precinct connecting two of Melbourne's largest boulevards along with Collins St West, making this location ideal for professional & personal lifestyle alike.

The specifications for security are met as the Gunnebo Speedstiles protect the workplace from unwanted visitors by detecting tailgating attempts and provides processing of people in both directions quickly and efficiently, is user friendly, reliable and robust.

Installed to site were 5 lanes of SpeedStile FP BA units, with 1800mm high glass. A combination unit was installed to allow for 4 narrow lanes, and one wide lane to accommodate for wheelchair access. The client opted for a black powder coated finish, which provides a sleek, modern design to the foyer of MQ2.



Challenges

Surrounding the project, extremely strict time frames for delivery were handed down. The products were expected to be on site by a particular date in January 2020, with no exceptions. With the time of year, meant world wide closures for the festive season, this was made a challenge for all, but a challenge with a positive result and deadlines fulfilled.

To ensure this result, the choice to Air freight the products was opted for. Although products were delivered on time, the external hurdle of COVID-19 brought installation to a near halt for a short period of time.



Results

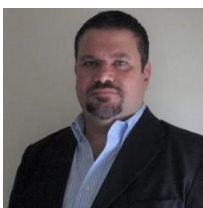
Building 2, which is set to house thousands of employees from multiple corporations in the coming months will provide effortless entry for all guests and employees alike.
